As the Long-Term Recovery Coordinator, a Disaster Case Manager, a Volunteer Coordinator, or an Outreach Coordinator, you will have opportunity to **join an exciting team and be part of a larger community of support coming alongside the survivors of the 2017 Northern California Wildfires.**

The Long-Term Recovery Coordinator works from the North Bay, supervising recovery staff and engaging with each of the Long-Term Recovery Groups in Mendocino, Lake, Sonoma and Napa Counties. The ability to travel to each of the areas is a necessity. **Disaster Case Managers** are needed in Sonoma and Mendocino Counties, and a part time **Volunteer Coordinator** is being sought for Sonoma County.

The role of all engaged in UMCOR’s Disaster Response Ministry is to help alleviate suffering and be a source of help and hope for those left most vulnerable by disaster.

Positions available are listed below with job descriptions attached. All positions are made possible through an UMCOR grant and hired through/as a temporary contracted position.
